Rio Tinto Naturescape Kings Park (RTNKP) is open during its standard hours of 9am to 4pm Tuesday to Sunday.

Total Fire bans, Fire Danger ratings for Bushfire Season

Bushfire season has drawn to a close, however we are now coming into the wetter months of the year.

During this period closures may be enforced for the below reasons for visitor safety:

- Severe Weather Warning
- Severe Thunderstorm Warning
- Extreme Wind Warnings

PMOs or BGPA Management will notify you when this is the case, please be aware that these warnings can be announced with short notice.

When the above warnings are announced RTNKP, Lotterywest Walkway and guided walks will be cancelled, with notices placed on the BGPA website.

SpinWay Bicycle Hire

As of 5 June 2025, all hiring of e-scooters will be suspended in City of Perth and Kings Park until further notice.

Works around the Park

Kaarta Moor (Mount Eliza Escarpment) Works Program

The removal of significant trees carrying the Polyphagous Shot-hole Borer has continued.

The tree removal works between Kings Tower and the Kokoda Steps are complete and Lovers Walk has been permanently closed. This area is now undergoing an extensive redesign with replanting of 20,000 plants planned across this winter. Ngooninup - Drainage Improvement Project

As part of the Ngooninup Scarp Stability Project, essential upgrades to the drainage network along the top of the escarpment has commenced.

The main purpose of this project is to mitigate overland flow throughout three sites and subsequently prevent erosion, pooling, and sediment transfer down Mt Eliza. The works will include construction of new gullies, side entry pits, underground cells and soakwells to capture and infiltrate surface water runoff. The works will also include amendments to hardscape areas, the introduction of garden beds to naturally infiltrate water, alterations of retaining walls and the construction of new walls.

The works will be rolled out concurrently across three sites:

These works have been timed to minimise disruption to Lightscape and other planned events. Pedestrian and traffic management will be in place throughout the works.

Forrest Carpark

Operations access through Forrest Carpark will be available, however no public access. Turf reinstatement works on Forrest lawn may continue following completion of the drainage works.

Kaarta Gar-up

Access onto Kaarta Gar-up will remain open from Fraser Ave, however no through access for pedestrians will be available. Some disruption on Fraser Ave will occur due to the refurbishment and installation of new pits in this area. Further information regarding this will be communicated later.

Bali Memorial / Rifle Range

All pedestrian movement between Bellevue Terrace and Rotary Wishing Well will be along Fraser Avenue only.
